UPDATED STATEMENT

We are facing a unique season in the life of our church. We want you to know that the health and safety of our community is a high priority to us, and we have taken steps to help protect from the spread of the coronavirus.

1) At this time, in accordance with Federal guidelines, and Governor Ivey's 25-person limit on gatherings, all services are moving online. There will be no official gathering at the church for worship services, but as we prepare online recordings, some staff and leaders will be needed to produce and create the music, lessons, and videos. These folks will keep healthy practices, while providing for you a version of our weekly worship experience

2) All other programs and ministries, including Sunday School, Sunday evenings, and Wednesday evenings will also be temporarily suspended.

3) In the absence of some of our Sunday night worship service and our Wednesday Bible Study a live video devotional will be posted on our Facebook. For Sunday School, we will record a video devotional during the week and post it on our website, YouTube channel, and Facebook feed on Saturday mornings to be viewed at your convenience.
